- B. Computation of the Fourth Quarter and Final Grade
 - 1. Results of the online Written Works and Performance-Based Tasks will be computed to generate equivalent grades. Online Computed Grades will be converted into points using the transmutation table below:

Transmutation table	Points
99-95	2 points
94-90	1.75 points
89-85	1.5 points
84-80	1.25 points
79-75	1 point
74 and below	No point

- For Pre-school to Grade 10, Fourth Quarter grade is based on the average grade from First to Third Quarter plus the points earned thru online activities and assessments. For the Senior High School, same formula will apply but will include only the Third quarter grade per subject.
- 3. Averaging System will be applied to compute for the Final Grade. Grades from First to Fourth Quarters will be part of the computation from Preschool to Junior High School, while Third and Fourth Quarters for the Senior High School.
- 4. All students are expected to participate in the online learning sessions in lieu of the face-toface classes. Participation in the activities provided in the online learning platforms will help students acquire the competencies and improve their grades.
- 5. This formula is based on the recommendation of the Education Undersecretary Alain Pascua to use a special formula in computing the final grades of the students, which was released last March 13, 2020.

Note: For those who do not have access to the internet due to the enhanced community quarantine or total lockdown, and do not have internet connection at home, the Final Grade of the learners will be the average of their grades from First to Third Quarter. The learners are advised to read their textbooks and other educational books they have at home.

- C. Academic Ranking and Awards
 - 1. Honors, Academic Excellence Award and designations will be based on the Final Average Grade of the learners.

D. Other Concerns

1. Rechecking of test paper for the Third Quarter Exam will be done once the suspension of classes is lifted.
